**The Criminal Justice (Proceeds of Crime) (Bailiwick of Guernsey)
(Amendment) Regulations, 2006***Made* 27 November 2006*Laid before the States* 2007*Coming into operation* 1 February 2007

THE STATES POLICY COUNCIL, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section 49 of the Criminal Justice (Proceeds of Crime) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law, 1999, as amended^a, hereby makes the following Regulations:-

Record-keeping for financial services businesses.

1. In the Criminal Justice (Proceeds of Crime) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Regulations, 2002^b, Regulation 5 is amended as follows-

(a) for paragraph (1) there shall be substituted-

"(1) A financial services business shall retain-

(a) the original, or

(b) a complete copy of the original,

of each customer document and customer verification document for at least the minimum retention period.",

(b) paragraph (2) shall be deleted,

(c) for paragraph (3) there shall be substituted-

"(3) Documents or copies of documents retained under this Regulation may be retained in any manner and in any form whatsoever, provided that their retrieval shall be readily practicable.",

(d) in paragraph (4) after the word "original" in both places where it occurs there shall be inserted the words "or copy".

2. These Regulations may be cited as the Criminal Justice (Proceeds of Crime) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment) Regulations, 2006.
